Mission

The Education committee aims to provide a diverse audience of standards volunteers with education and resources to support their professional growth and participation in standards.

Charge

The Education committee seeks to offer guidance and education on interaction, personal communication and leadership sharing in the execution of its work and as a consensus group that operates in the framework of guidance and procedures set out by Women in Standards.

The committee assists in the development of educational content including presentations, classes, and other materials to support the professional development of the Women in Standards members and the broader standardization community.

The work of the committee is supported through discussions with stakeholders, research of relevant content, and surveys, among other activities. The membership includes individuals from the standardization community, stakeholders, and other interested parties.

Rules on committee member eligibility and participation and the conducting of committee business is addressed in the Women in Standards Committee Bylaws.

Key Responsibilities of the Committee on Inclusiveness in Standards

1. Development of an educational framework for those volunteering and participating in standards development.
2. Identification of the training needs of the community.
3. Review and enhancement of current educational programs.
4. Promoting the importance of the use and implementation of standards.
5. Encouraging the participation of a diverse audience in the work of standards and standards development.
6. Research, review, and maintenance of up-to-date information related to standards development.
